There would be advertising screens for DMEA and the Chamber. They will pay all costs. Nathan is discussing this proposition with them.

Committee Reports:

- Downtown improvement proposal was discussed by Wills. Basically will continue those things that have been started. The Chamber can work with the town to bring people together to make the downtown more attractive. The flowers are a big improvement.
- The Downtown Merchants committee have planned an art walk from noon to 3:00 on Saturday July 14, in association with the Hotchkiss Fine Arts Association. It was suggested that the DMC have a logo so their advertising is more identifiable. They meet the 3rd Tuesday of each month at the Coal Train.
